**STUDY TOUR, 12-14 JUNE 2010**

The Lismore conference will be followed by a three-day study tour in north-eastern New South Wales and south-eastern Queensland, encompassing visits to a variety of historical sites and forest ecosystems, and other places of interest to forest historians. The price will depend upon the number of participants, but in any event will be **no greater than \$500** per person. This is inclusive of all meals and bus travel, and accommodation on a shared or double basis. Single rooms can be had for an additional \$150 (two nights).
